Temporary Regulations for visiting Gross-Rosen Museum.

Nazi German concentration and death camp 1940-1945

during the epidemic SARS CoV-2

1. Gross-Rosen Museum is open from Monday to Sunday between 9:00 – 16:00. The last entry is at 15:30.

2. For touring Museum makes available the site of the former concentration camp GrossRosen with the site of the historical quarry – place of martyrdom of Gross-Rosen prisoners, as well as permanent and temporary exhibitions. In order to learn about availability of exhibits, please ask the employee at Tourists Service Office (the building near the entry barier.)

3. Visitors can commemorate the victims of the camp by lightning a candle or lay

bouquets under the Mausoleum monument.

4. The site of the former concentration camp is available for individual visitors as well as for

guided tours (groups of up to 5 people are allowed.)

5. Individual touring should take place according to the map on the board located on the right site

of the road that leads from the parking lot to the main building.

6. On the Museum site 24 boards with information about historical building and places

are located. Descriptions on those boards are in 3 languages (in Polish, English and

German). In a way they form a museum guide and indirectly determine the route of

touring.

7. To 5th June the Museum makes the indor exhibitions available under the following conditions:

-no more than one person for 15 m2

-visitors must wear masks

8. Excluded from this requirement are: parents with children need of care (up to 13 years

old), disabled people, people unable to move independently, people with a certificate

of need for special education and their guardians.

9. From 15th to 28th May tere is a possibility of having educational activities open air for groups of 15 pupils maximum, minding that the participants keep the distance of 1.5 metres.

10. From 29th May tere is a possibility of having educational activities indoors for groups of 15 pupils maximum, minding that the participants keep the distance of 1.5 metres and wear masks.

Additional information:

11. After entering the Museum parking lot visitors are obliged to visit a sanitary point, that is located near Tourist Service Office to disinfect their hands and are obliged to wear masks.

12. Only one person can stay at the cash window (in building next to the car park).

13. We encourage you to pay by card.

14. The visitors standing in the line to the cash window and during their visit on the site of

the Museum are obliged to keep a distance of 1.5 meters between them.

15. In the Museum main building and in its lower level, toilets will be

available for visitors.

16. The number of people visiting the site of the Museum is monitored by employees of the Tourist Service Office.

17. Compliance with sanitary requirements by the visitors are supervised by Museum caretakers and guides by surveillance cameras.
